VIN GRIS OF PINOT NOIR CENTRAL COAST

In 1975, legendary vintner and pioneer Josh Jensen founded Calera (Spanish for “lime kiln”) high in the Gabilan Mountains of California's majestic Central Coast. In the five decades since, Calera has helped establish the Central Coast as one of the New World's most exciting wine regions while earning acclaim as one of California's iconic wineries.

VINTAGE NOTES

Across the Central Coast, the 2025 vintage began with late spring rains and average seasonal rainfall overall. Cool, wet conditions in March and April delayed budbreak, while mild temperatures throughout late spring and summer extended the growing season. Harvest progressed slowly and steadily from mid-September through late October, with long hang times yielding wines defined by vibrant fruit and fresh acidity.

WINEMAKING NOTES

This Vin Gris of Pinot Noir opens with aromas of fresh strawberry and lemongrass. The bright, refreshing palate offers notes of orange peel and tart raspberry, leading to a crisp, lively finish.
